Come see Alaska's most exciting dog sport!

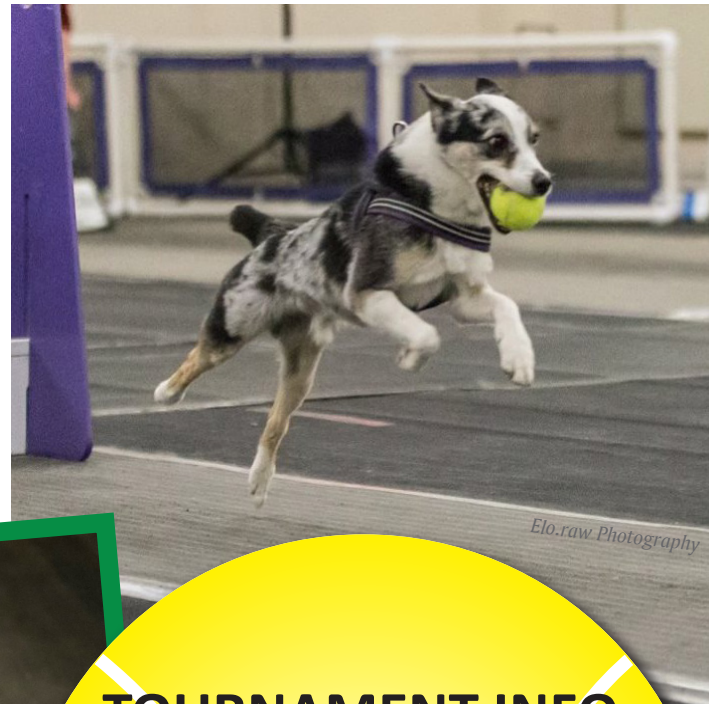


Drag racing for dogs!
